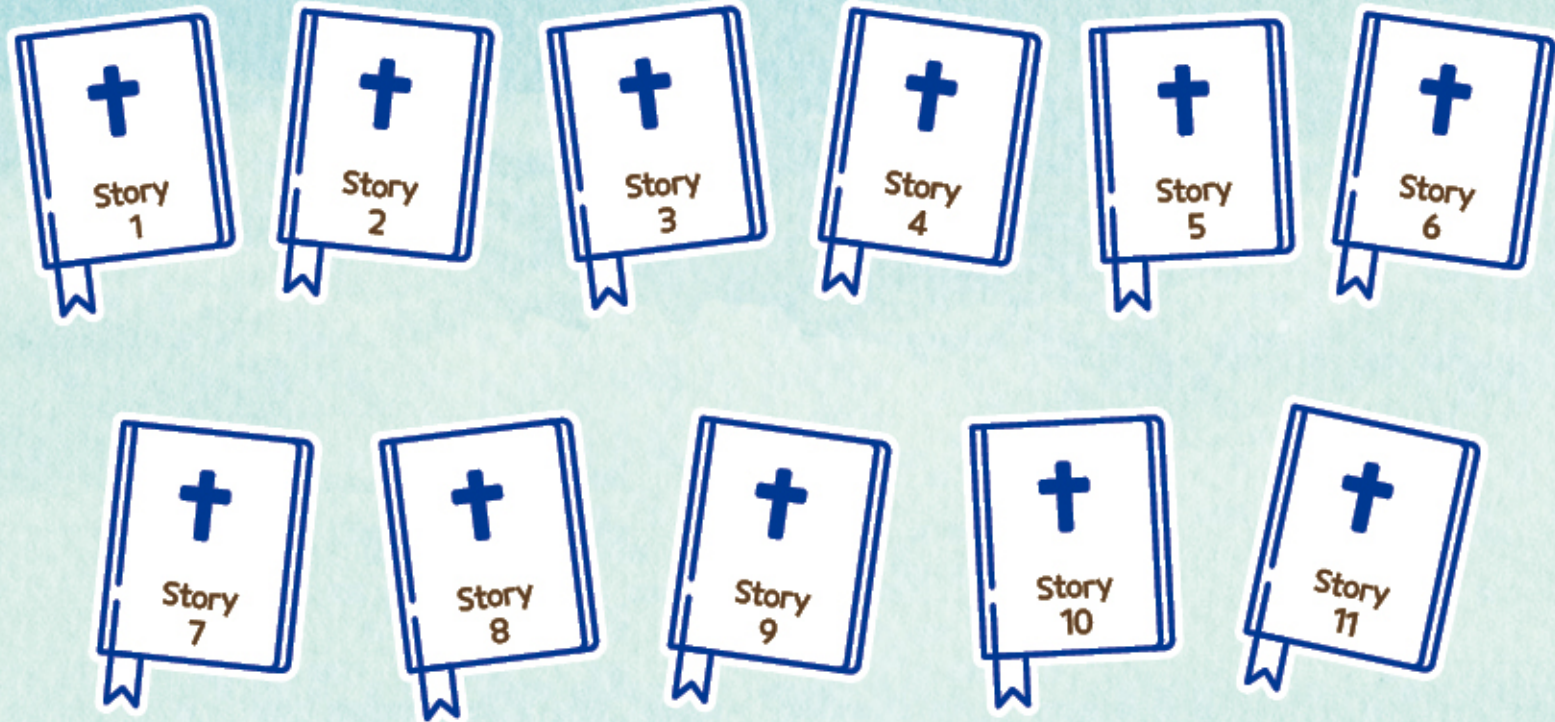

Story 1: The Beggar Lazarus

[Luke 16:25]

"But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember what happened in your lifetime. You received your good things. Lazarus received bad things. Now he is comforted here, and you are in terrible pain.'

Long ago there lived a very rich man. He lived in a fancy house and wore very expensive clothes. Every day he ate the finest meals and lived in luxury. The rich man gathered people to his home every day for a feast. He did not believe in God and lived only for himself.
