

Story 3 : The Triumphal Entry

Main Bible verse
[Mark 11:10]

"Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David!"
"Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

The Passover holiday of Israel had arrived. The Passover reminded the Israelites of how God liberated them from slavery in Egypt under the leadership of Moses.

To celebrate the festival of the Passover, everyone gathered at the temple in Jerusalem. While many people went to Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover, Jesus had another reason and He also went. 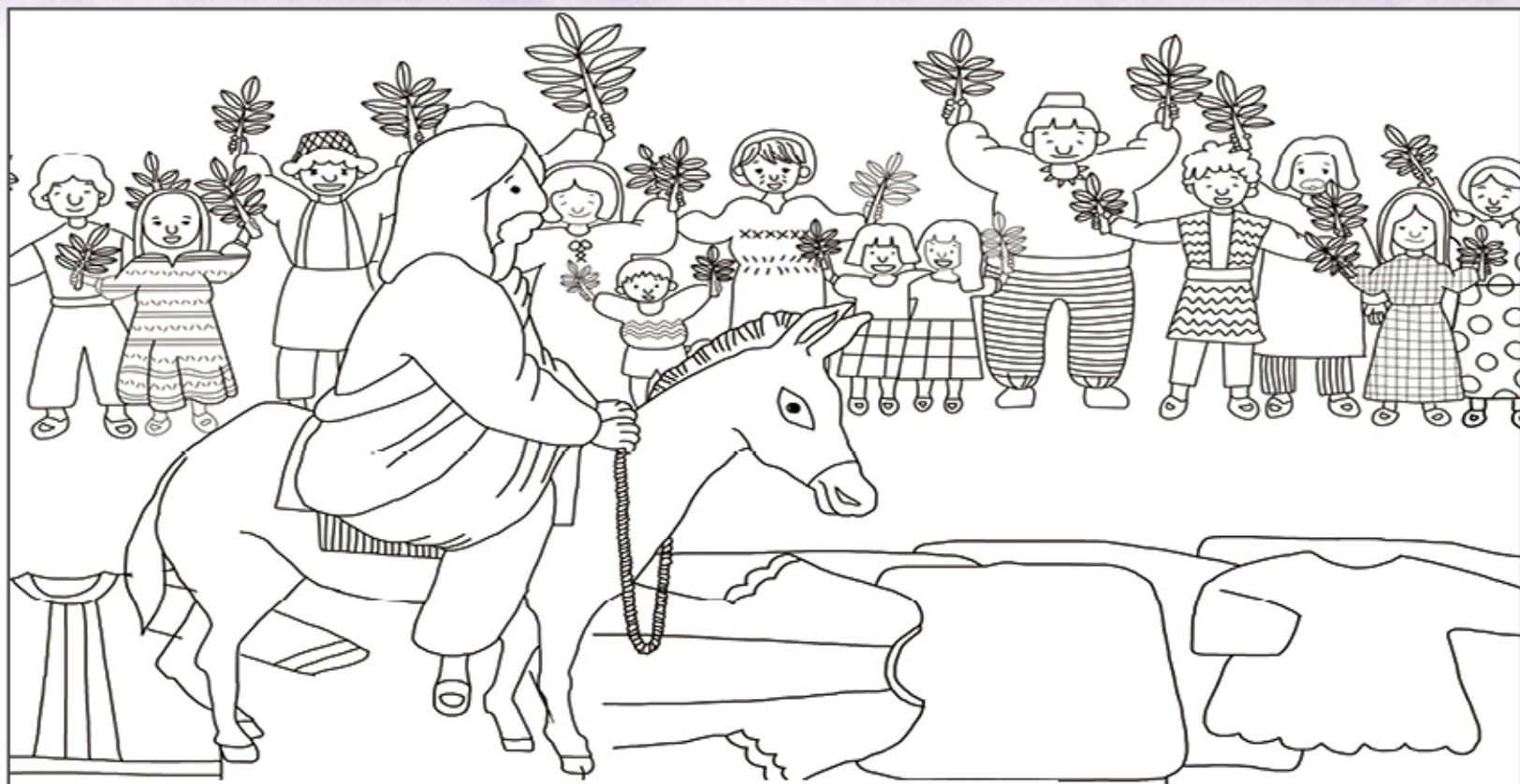

Think about what we learned today and color the picture below.

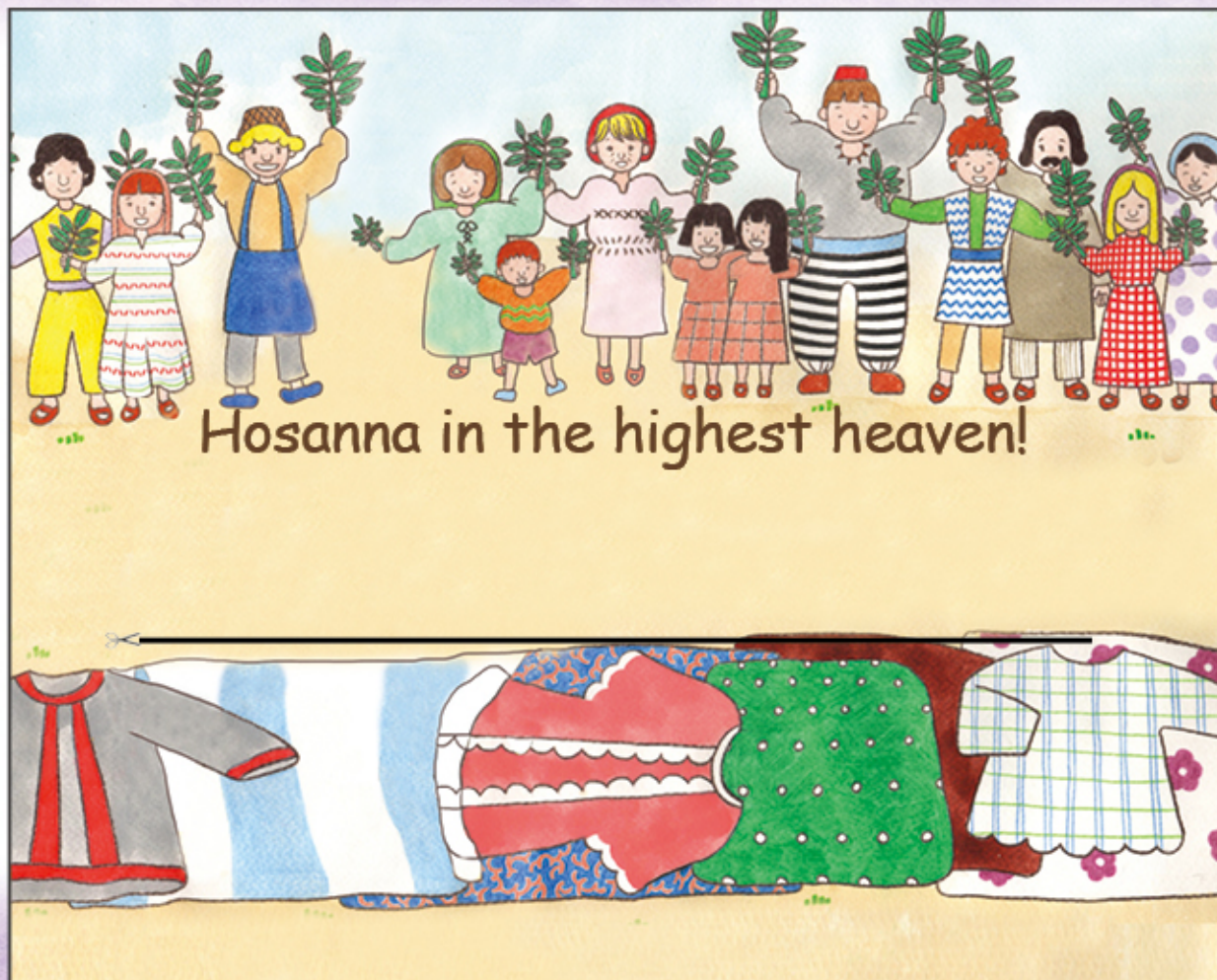


- Trace and memorize the Bible verse. (Mark 11:10)
