When these things happened after the Holy Spirit came, Those who saw them praised Jesus' disciples and those who believed in him and were saved by believing in God.

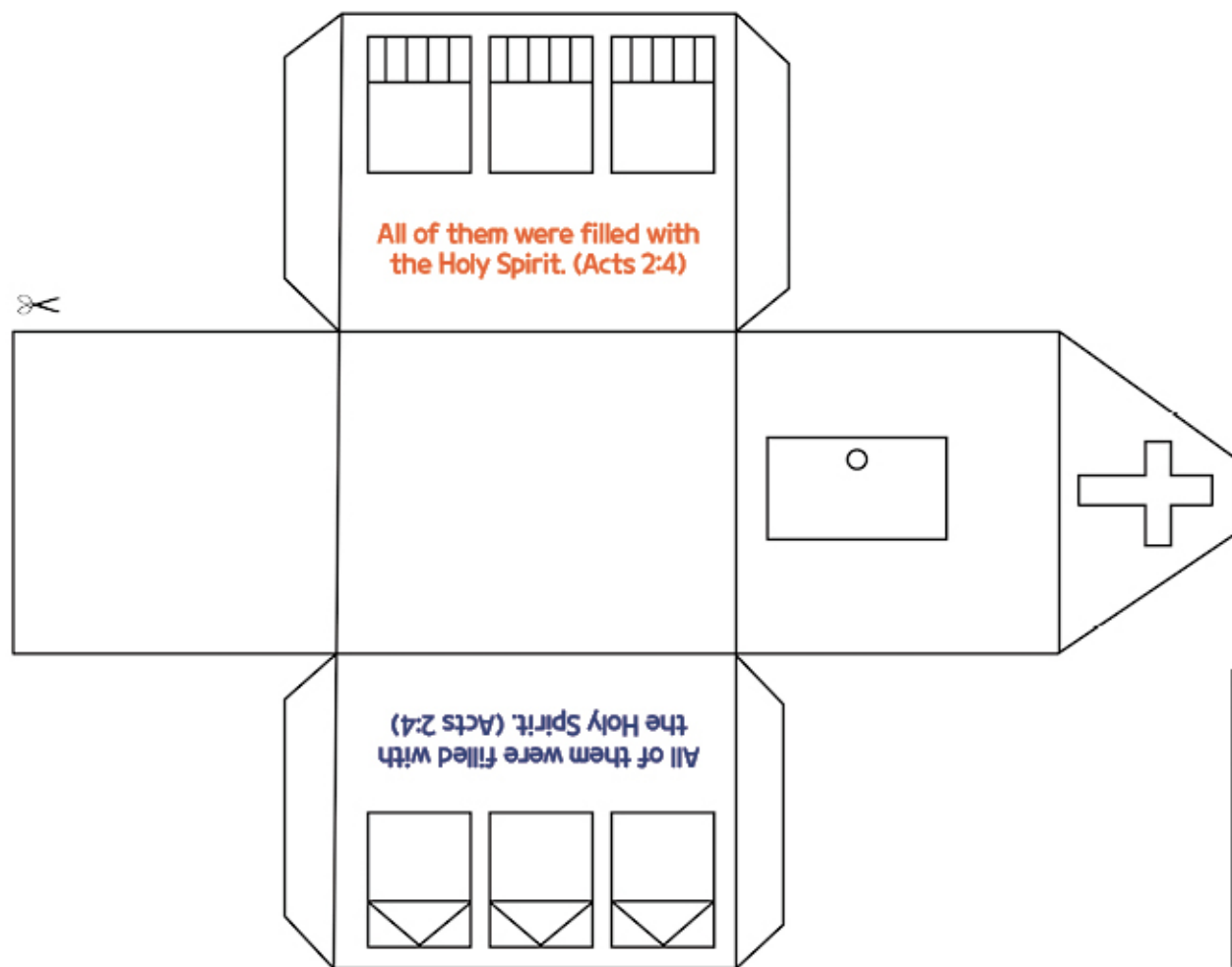
This was the First Church.
