

Story 2 : The Birth of Christ

Main Bible verse
[Isaiah 7:14]
[Matthew 1:23]

"The virgin is going to have a baby. She will give birth to a son.
And he will be called Immanuel." (Isaiah 7:14)
The name Immanuel means "God with us." (Matthew 1:2)

Years and years ago, Mary lived in a little town called Nazareth in Israel. Mary was engaged to be married to Joseph, a kind-hearted carpenter. At the time, Israel was ruled by King Herod who did not believe in God.

It was late but Joseph and Mary could not find a place to stay: there was already a lot of people there.

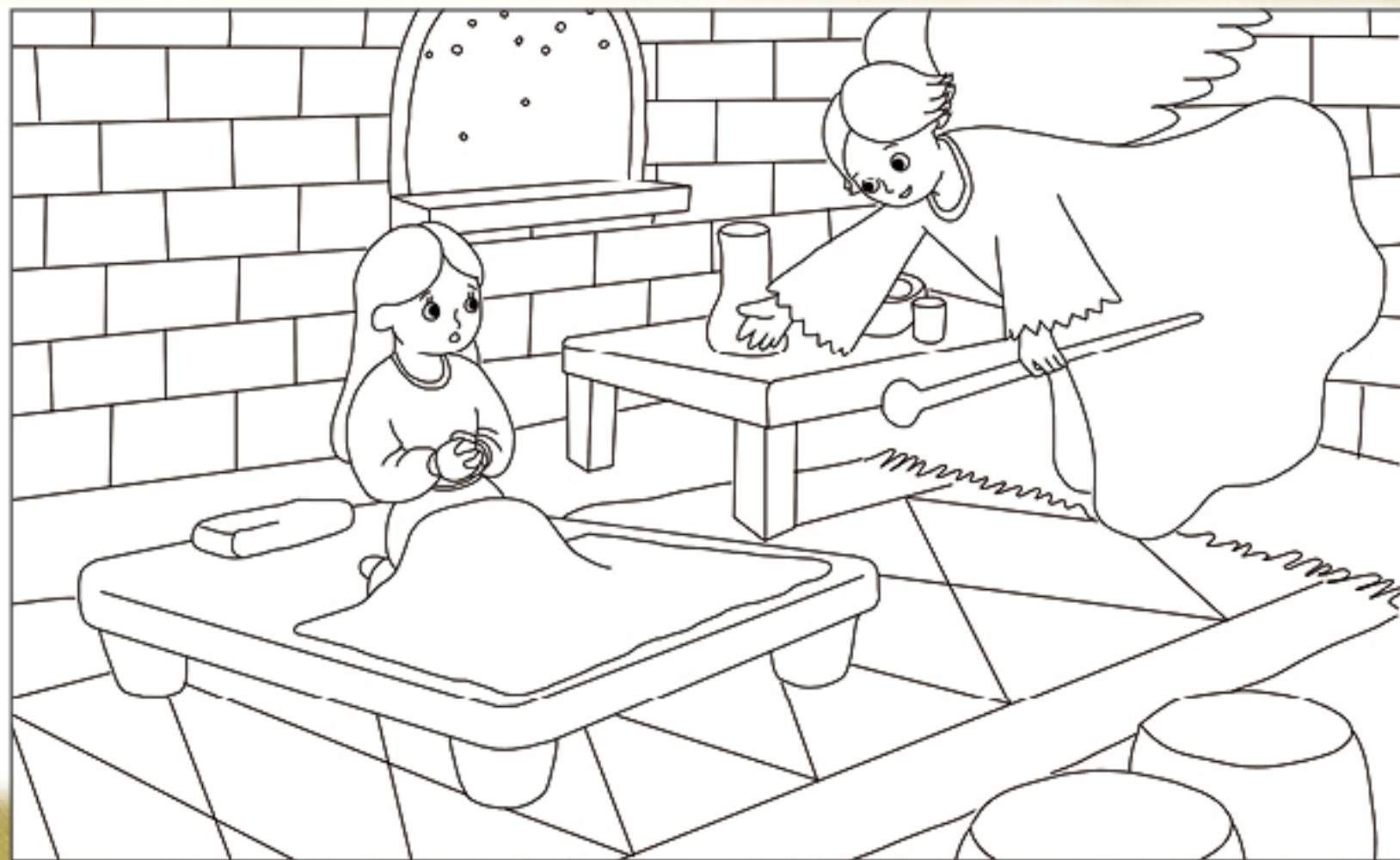
The two who could not find a place to stay finally found rest in a stable where horses eat and sleep.

Think about what we learned today and color the picture below.

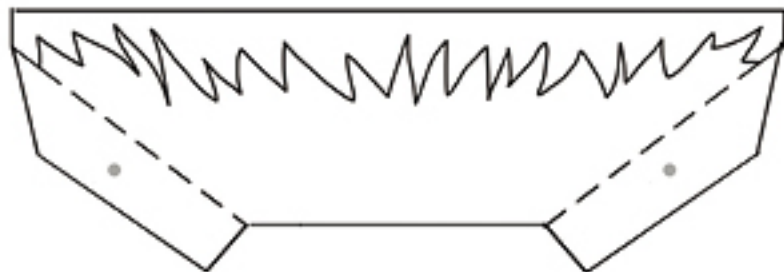


- Trace and memorize the Bible verse. (Matthew 1:23)
