

Story 3 : Jesus loves the little children

Main Bible verse
[Matthew 19:14]

Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me.
Don't keep them away.
The kingdom of heaven belongs to people like them."

Jesus arrived in a Jewish village with his disciples to preach the Word of the Kingdom of God.

Wherever Jesus went crowds gathered.

Among them were parents who had brought their young children with them.
