And they brought the wine to the master of the feast.

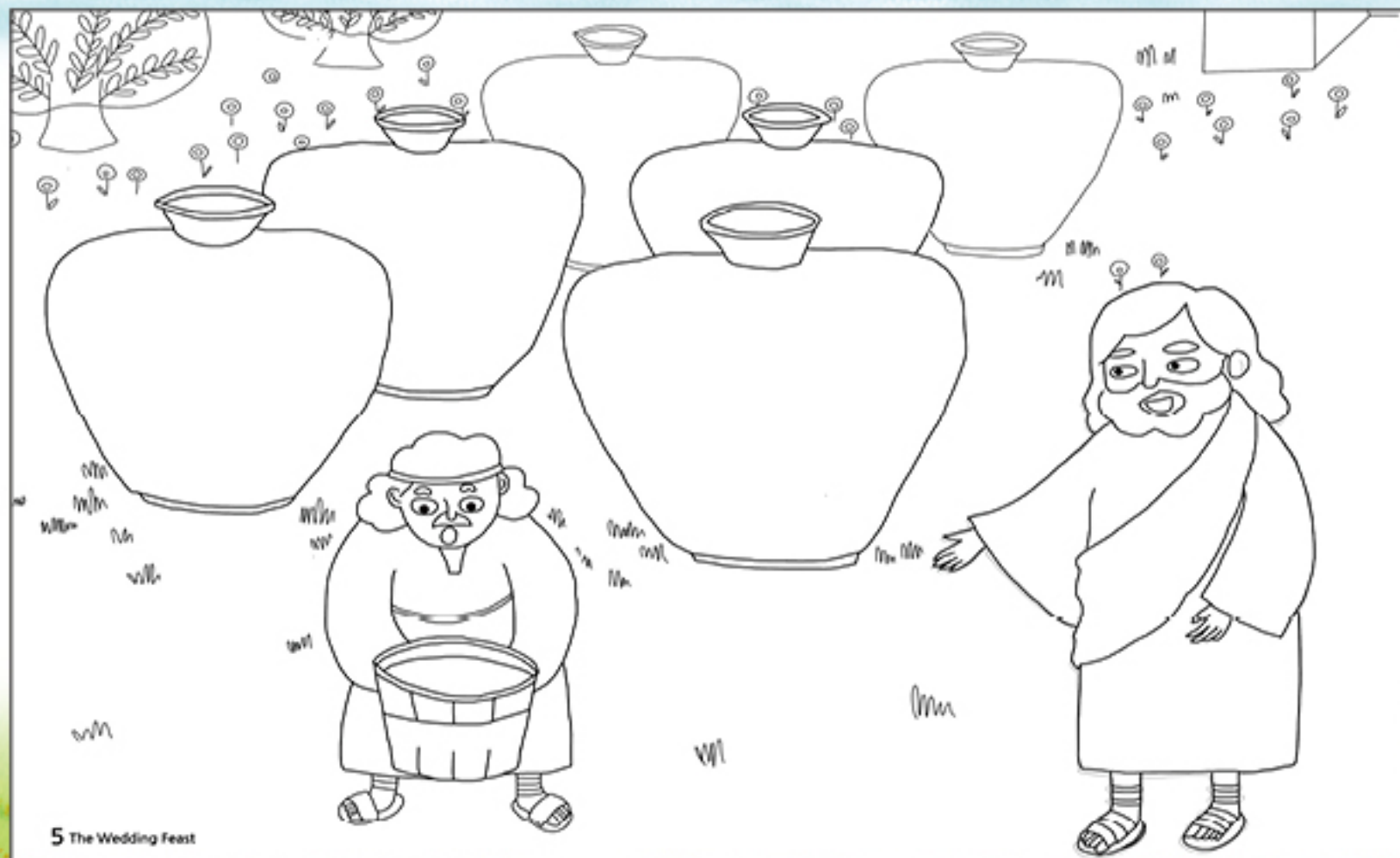
The master of the feast did not know where this wine had come from but excited,

Think about what we learned today and color the picture below.

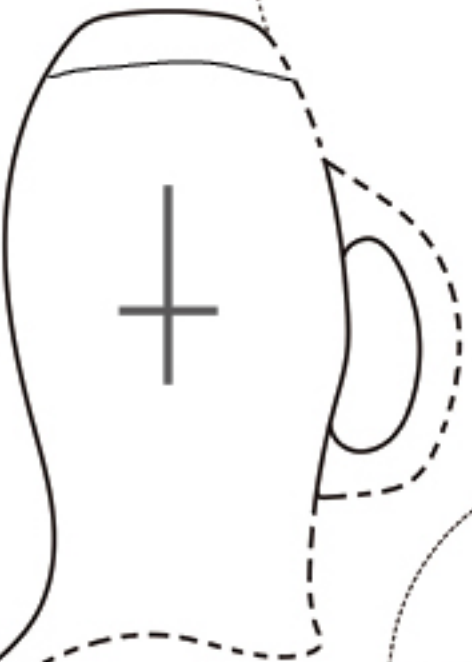
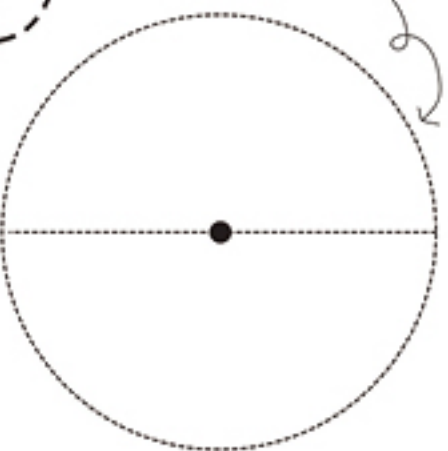
