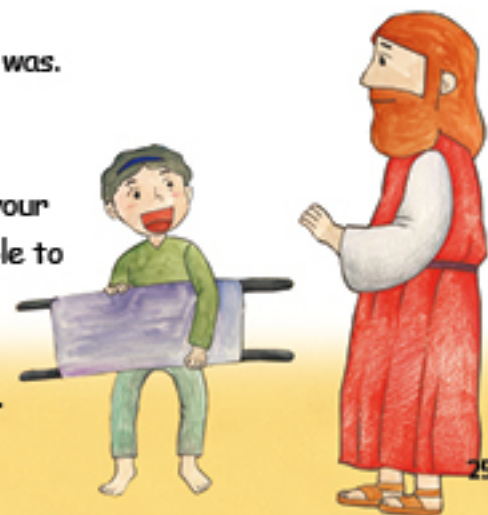


Story 6 : The Paralyzed man

[Luke 5:24b]

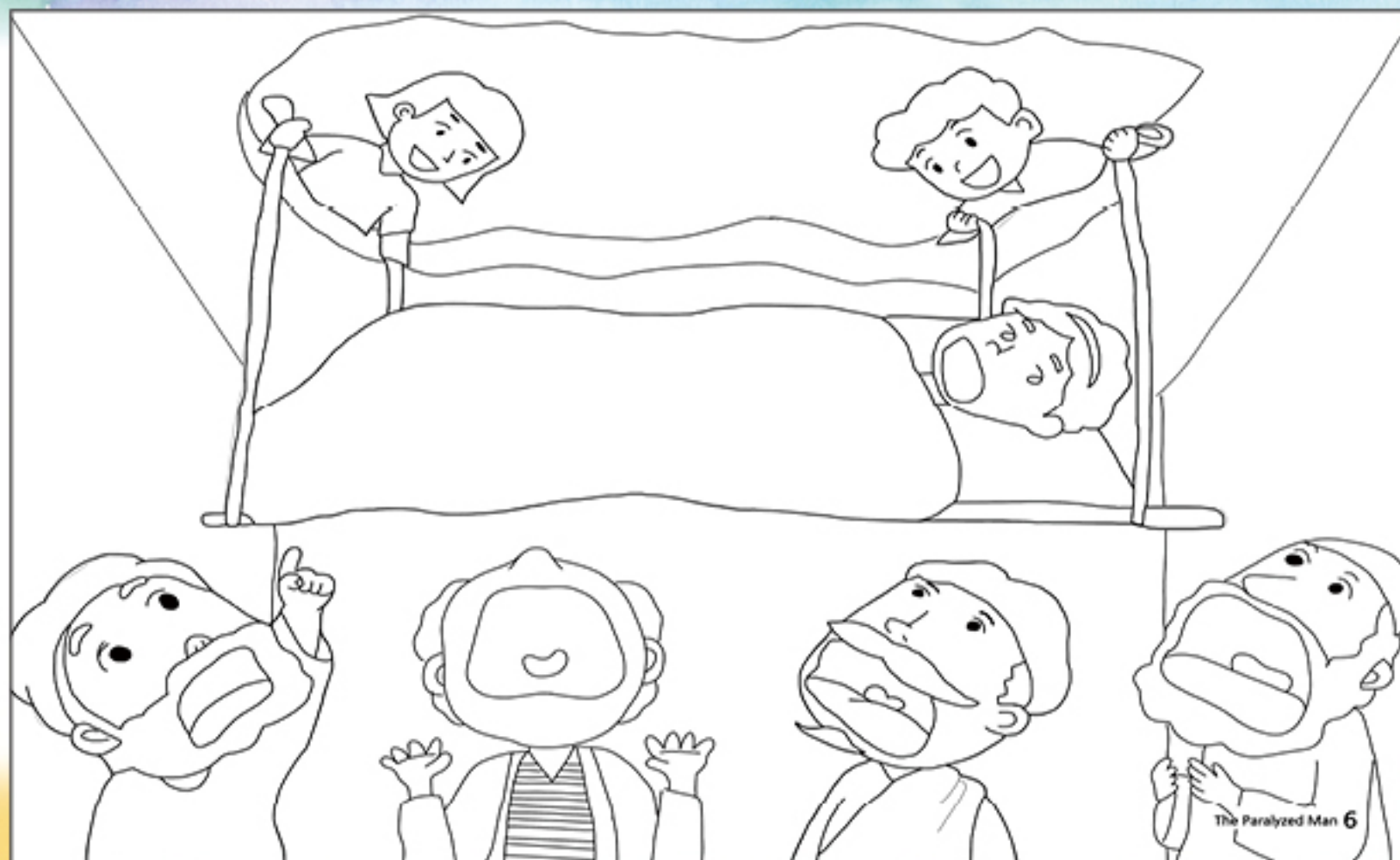
So he spoke to the man who could not walk. "I tell you," he said,
