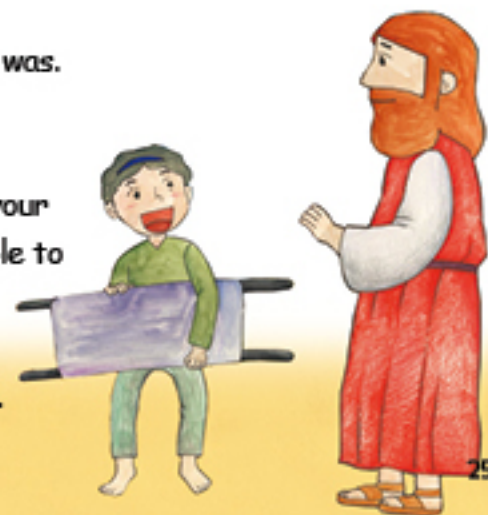


Story 6 : The Paralyzed man
