

Story 7 : Five Loaves & Two Fish

Main Bible verse
[Luke 9:16]

Jesus took the five loaves and the two fish. He looked up to heaven and gave thanks. He broke them into pieces. Then he gave them to the disciples to give to the people.

One day, Jesus was preaching on the shore of the Sea of Galilee.

A great crowd of people followed him because they had heard of all the great miracles he had performed.
