Narration The disciples can't say anything at all.



Jesus You haven't had breakfast yet, (have you?) Come and have breakfast.

Disciples (Disciples cry)

Narration Jesus gives them bread and grilled fish. J: Yum! It's been a long time since we've eaten together.

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Narration They enjoy breakfast with Jesus. After the meal, Jesus asks Simon Peter.

Jesus Simon, son of John, do you really love me more than these others do?

Peter Yes? Yes, Lord. I love you.

Jesus Peter, feed my lambs..... Simon, son of John, do you really love me?

Peter Yes, Lord. You know that I love you.

Jesus Take care of my sheep..... Simon, son of John, do you love me?

Narration Peter feels bad because Jesus asks the same question three times.

Peter Lord, you know all things. You know that I love you.

Narration Jesus says to all of his disciples as well as Simon Peter.

Jesus If you love me, feed my sheep.

Narration The disciples followed Jesus again. Jesus stayed with them, telling of God's Kingdom.

He also taught how to study the Bible. On the 40th day after his resurrection, he was taken up to heaven. It was the last time he was on the earth.
