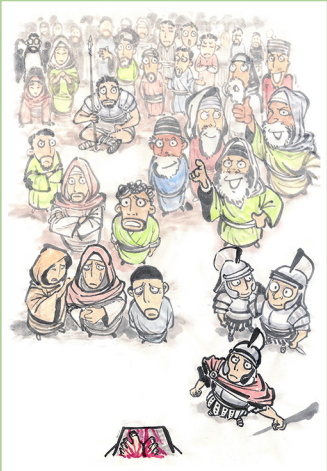
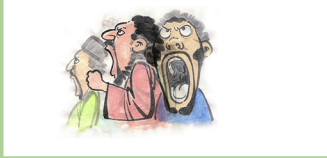


The Story of Jesus

Woman 2 Look! The tomb is open. Is anybody here?



- Narration** The women enter into the tomb. They are shocked and afraid. Jesus' body is not there.
- At that time, two people show up. They are shining like lightening. The women are afraid and bow down with their faces to the ground.
- Shiner** Why are you looking for Jesus in the tomb?
- He is not here. He has risen. He said he would rise. He said, the 'Son of Man will be nailed to a cross. On the third day, he will rise from the dead.' Jesus is going ahead of you into Galilee. Tell his disciples and Peter.
- Narration** The women are afraid, but they are filled with joy. They hurry away from the tomb.
- They run to the disciples to tell this. The tomb is empty. Jesus has risen from the dead.
