David Without even properly understanding this law, we placed the sacred ark of God on a cart pulled by an animal. A precious life was sacrificed because of our ignorance of God's words.

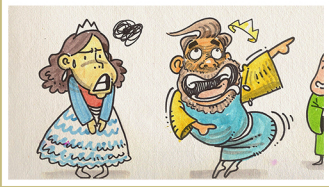
Servant 2 Your highness, now prepare the Levi priests and order them to move the ark of God here.
