Samuel lived to govern and guide the Israelites in the ways of the Lord and God appointed many kings of Israel through Samuel.

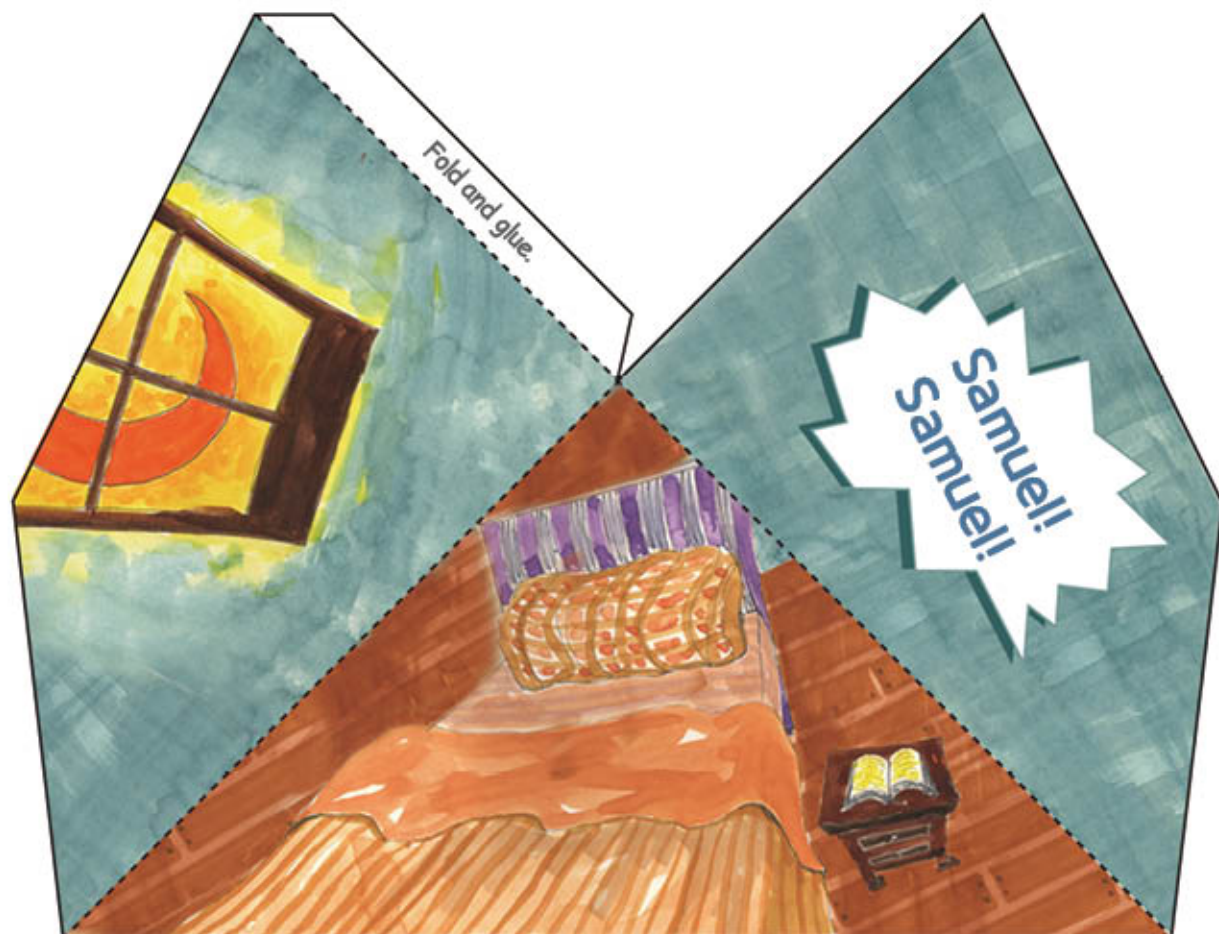
Samuel was a great man; he was a prophet who taught and shared the words of God to the Israelites.
