Main Bible verse
[1 Kings 17:24]

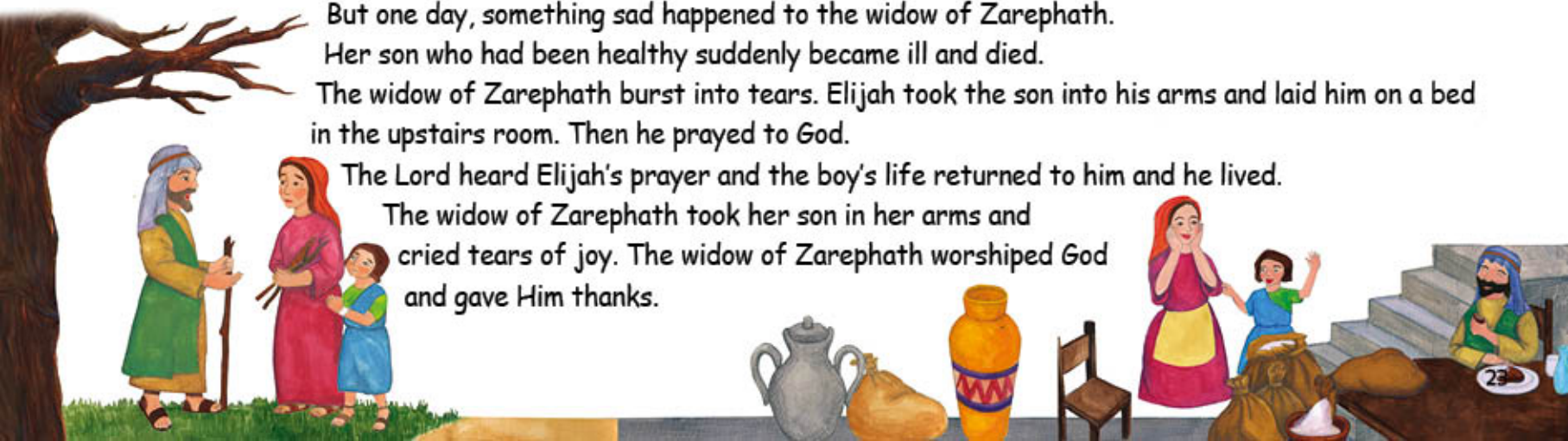
But one day, something sad happened to the widow of Zarephath.
