

Telling what God has done!



- Narration** One day, Paul and Barnabas and their group was preaching the gospel in Lystra. There was a man with a lame leg, who had neer been able to walk since his birth. He was listening to Paul's sermon. Apostle Paul kept his eyes on the man.
- Paul** That person sitting over there is so concentrated. It is clear that he's hope and faith are growing through my sermon!
- Narration** And then he spoke out loud to him.
- Paul** Hey there!
- Disabled** Are you talking to me?
- Paul** Now get up and stand upright!
- Disabled** Yes sir... Uh? I got strength in my leg..!!
- Narration** And then the man got up and started walking.
- Disabled** Wow! Amazing!! I'm walking! Everyone, look at me! I'm walking!!
- People** (sounds in surprise)
- Man 1** Oh wow,, how can he walk?
- Man 2** How can they do such a thing?
- Man 3** They must be God or something!
- Man 4** Yeah, right! God has appeared to us! That person who speaks well must be the god Hermes and that person must be the god Zeus!
- Narration** People were outraged that the gods of heaven had come down. There, the priest in the temple of Zeus prepared an ox and flowers to offer sacrifices to the apostles with he people.
- Priest** God has come down!
- Narration** As Barnabas and Paul saw this, they cried out in sorrow.
- Paul** What the heck is this!? We are just normal people like you all!
- Man 1** You are not a god? Then who the heck are you? (rumble)
- Barnabas** We are only here to preach the gospel to you , so that you may forsake these vain idols and come to know the living God!
- Paul** This God we tell you is the maker of the heavens, the earth, the seas and everything in them. This God has been giving you rain from heaven, making trees bear fruit and giving you food to fill your hearts till today.



Barnabas | We are just telling you who the one and only God is! Don't think we are God!

Narration | As the two apostles explained the gospel to the people again, they stopped them from offering sacrifices to them. So people came to know who God is by listening to the sermons of Barnabas and Paul. Paul and Barnabas put more effort into making God and Jesus Christ known through various occasions and events.
