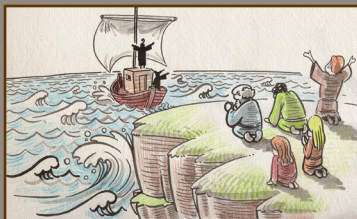


We can go everywhere, where God sends us!

- Narration** One day, while Paul was staying at Philip's house, a prophet named Agabus looked closely at Paul's belt and said:
- Agabus** Paul!!! And everyone! The holy spirit informed me! The owner of this belt will be subjected to great persecution in Jerusalem!
