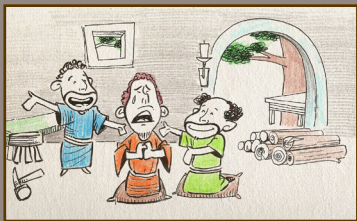


Barnabas and Saul make a great team together!



Narration After Deacon Stephen was stoned by the Jews, the Jews persecuted those who believed in Jesus even harshly.

Jews Capture all the Jesuits!

Soldier Follow me! Come on! Move!!

Narration Many believers were forced to leave Jerusalem due to persecution by the Jews. They went as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch. However, those who believed in Jesus also preached about Jesus in other countries where they fled.

Person 1 Hey, have you ever heard of Jesus of Nazareth?

Person 2 What? Jesus? Never heard the name. Who is he?

Person 1 Poor fellow... How do you not know Jesus? He is the Son of God. He came to this earth. But he died on the cross for our sins. And finally rose again.

Narration This way, the gospel continued to spread, and many people who heard the gospel repented and accepted the Lord.

Person 2 I repent of living my life the way I pleased. From now on, I will live in obedience to the words of Jesus.

Person 1 Oh brother~ You have entered the salvation of God~ Congratulations.

Narration Because God was with those who preached Jesus, the number of people who believed in the gospel increased every day, especially in Antioch. When the Jerusalem church heard that many people in Antioch believed in Jesus, they sent Barnabas there.

Jerusalem Church Brother Barnabas! Please go to Antioch, take good care of the saints, and spread the word of God properly.

Barnabas Yes, I see. Pray for my trip too.

Narration So Barnabas went to Antioch. When Barnabas arrived there, he shared to stories of the Bible and Jesus to the members of the Antioch Church and strengthened their faith.

Barnabas Jesus is the man mentioned in the Old Testament. God has finally sent him to us.

Narration Because Barnabas was a good man, full of faith and the Holy Spirit, more and more people believed in Jesus.

Barnabas Oh...It's all God's grace. I am just a useless servant.



- Narration** As the number of believers grew, Barnabas needed someone who could teach them well.
- Barnabas** I have to go to Tarsus and ask Saul to serve the Antioch church together. No one can do this better than Saul.
- Narration** So, Barnabas headed to Tarsus to meet Saul.
- Barnabas** God! Help us to be sure to work with Saul. God please.
I pray in the name of Jesus. Amen
- Narration** Saul mentioned here is the same Saul who was born again after meeting Jesus who persecuted the church before. When Barnabas arrived in Tarsus, he met Saul and asked to serve the church in Antioch.
- Barnabas** Saul, let's go to Antioch together. Please teach the believers properly with the gospel. I prayed a lot while coming here.
- Narration** After hearing Barnabas' request, Saul readily agreed and went to the church in Antioch together. Barnabas and Saul taught the Bible together at Antioch Church and preached the word of Jesus.
- Saul** Jesus told us to love one another.
- Narration** The members of Antioch Church, who were taught by Barnabas and Saul, obeyed the words of Jesus and lived a good and righteous life wherever they were.
- Person 1** Who are those people, looking so bright and happy?
- Person 2** Haven't you heard the rumors lately? People called them Christians. Living by keeping the word of Christ.
- Person 3** Christ? ? Ah, we should call them Christians from now.
- Narration** Since then, people who attended church were called Christians. Antioch Church stood strong day by day, receiving praise from people.
