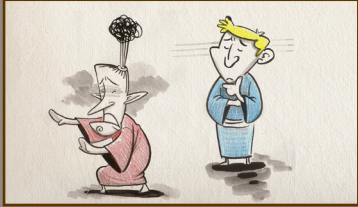


## Light for the Gentiles!

- Narration** So he disturbed Paul and Barnabas to preach the gospel.
- Barjesus** Lord, Governor! They are liars! Don't listen to them! Drive them out of this island!
