[Genesis 1:1]

On the fourth day, God said: "Let the sun, the moon, and stars appear in the sky!"

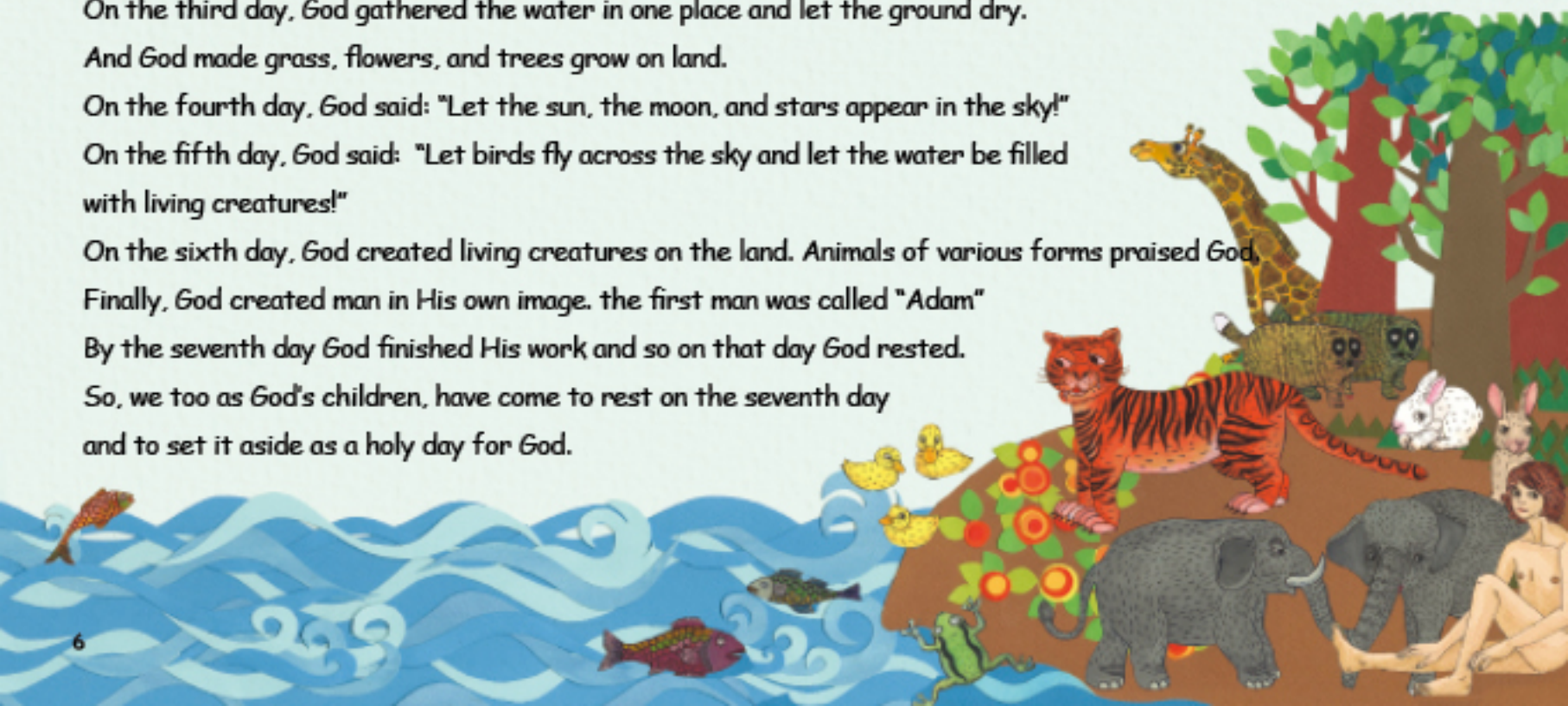
On the fifth day, God said: "Let birds fly across the sky and let the water be filled with living creatures!"
