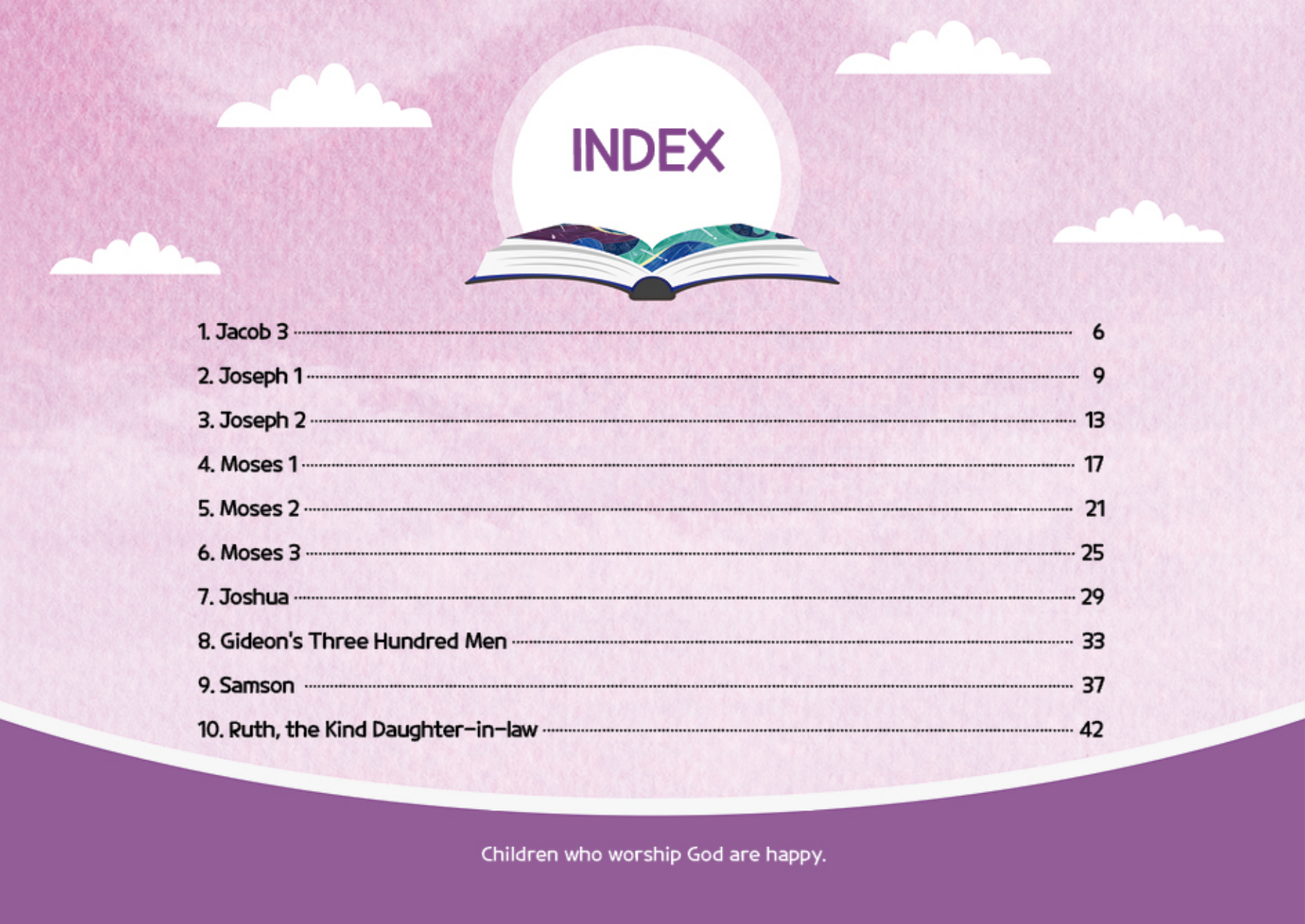

Jacob used all his strength to win.

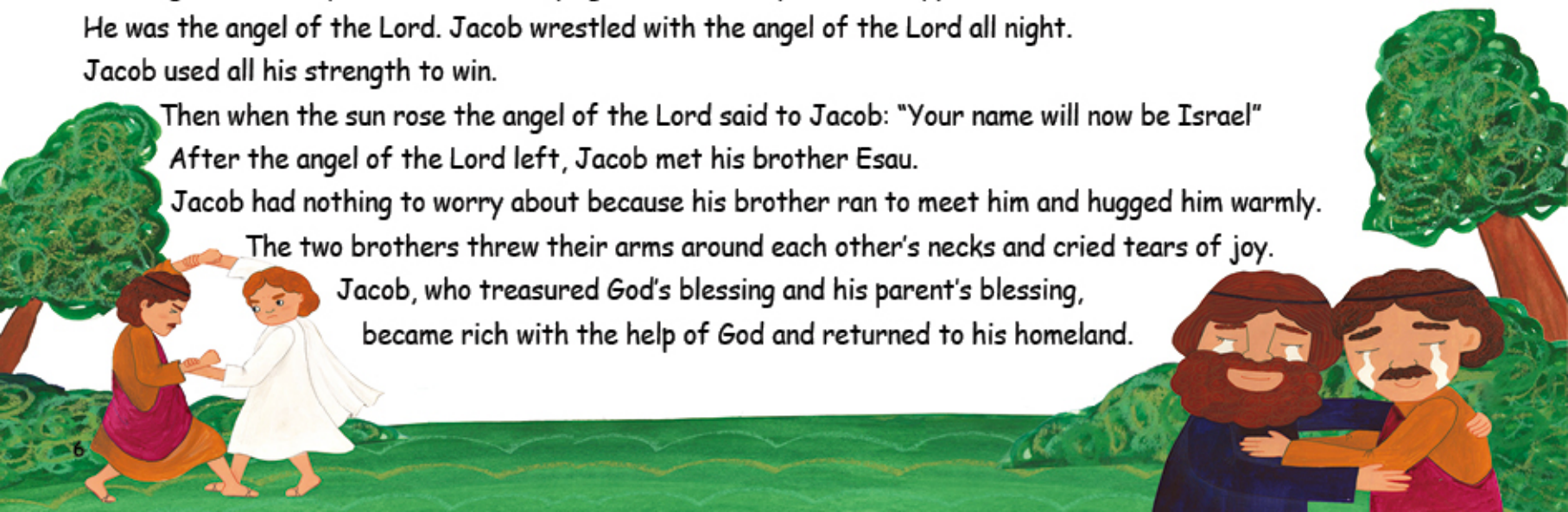
Then when the sun rose the angel of the Lord said to Jacob: "Your name will now be Israel"
