

Story 6: Moses 3

Main Bible verse
[Exodus 14:13]

Moses answered the people. He said, "Don't be afraid. Stand firm. You will see how the Lord will save you today. Do you see those Egyptians? You will never see them again."

Moses' and the Israelites' long journey to the land of Canaan had begun.

During the day, God protected them from the hot sun by a cloud, and during the night God guided them by a pillar of fire.

c. Read Exodus 14: 1-14 and answer: Who will fight against the Egyptians?



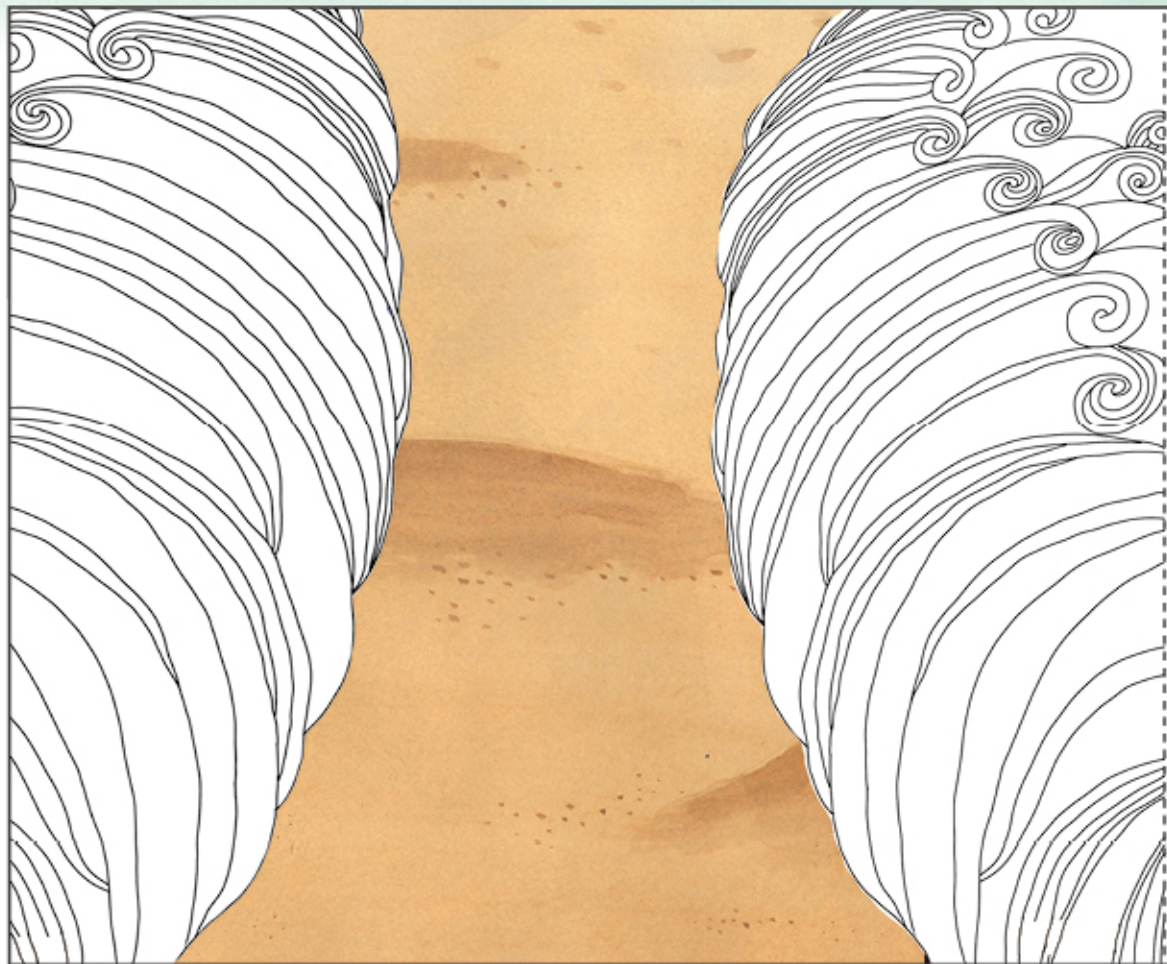
