Cain's heart was filled with resentment towards God and jealousy towards his younger brother.

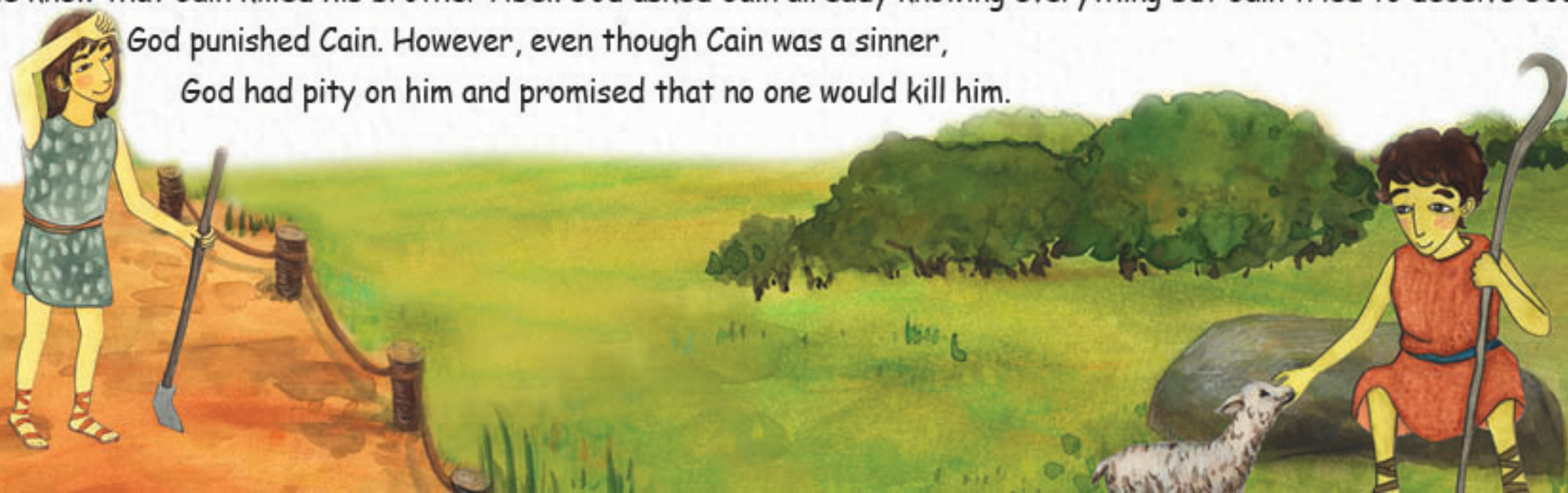
Then one day, Abel could not be found. God asked Cain: "Cain, where is Abel?" Cain answered:

He knew that Cain killed his brother Abel. God asked Cain already knowing everything but Cain tried to deceive God.

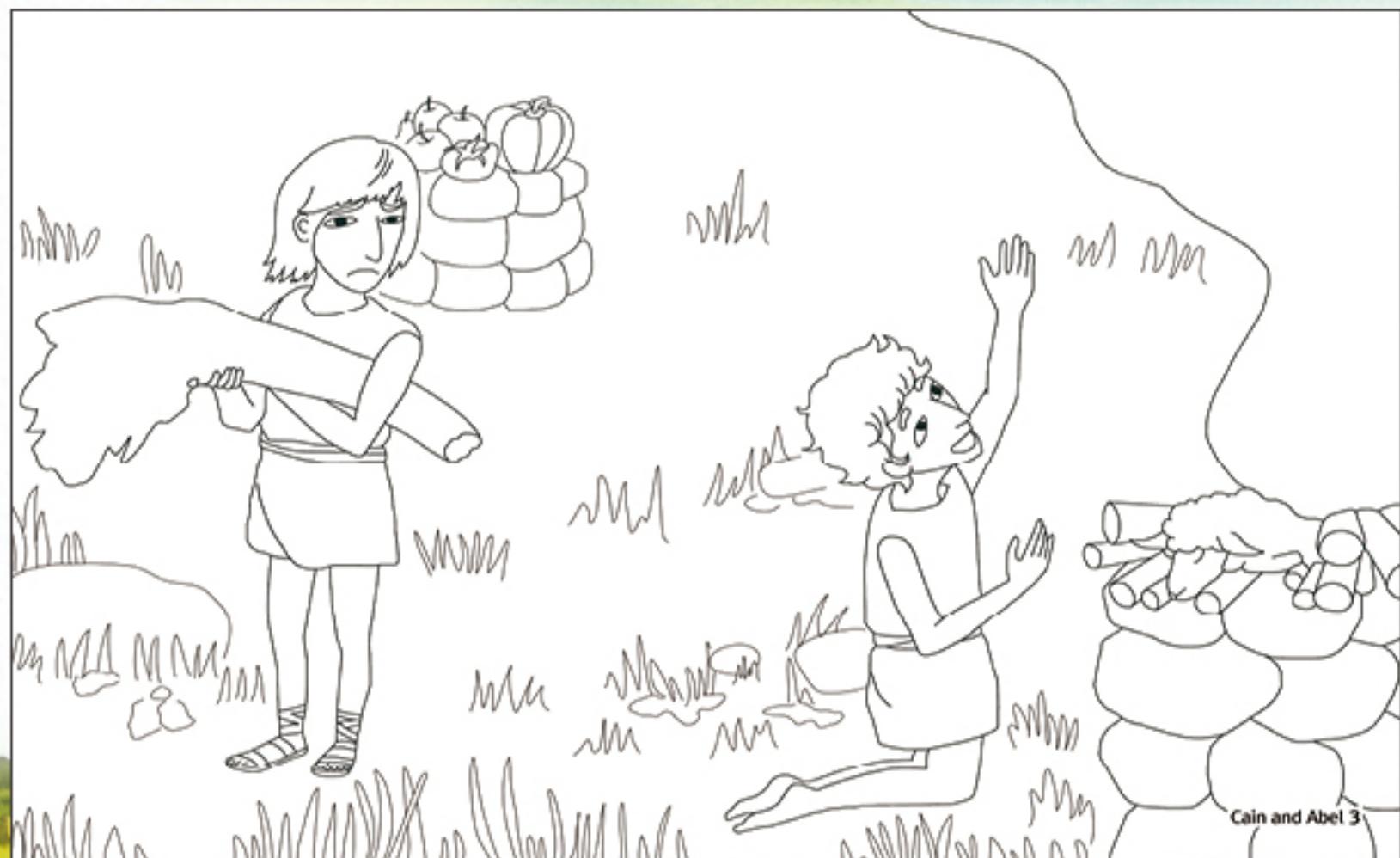
God punished Cain. However, even though Cain was a sinner,
